On August 16, 2012, the Wisconsin Real Estate Examining Board issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") requiring Respondent to complete fifteen (15) hours of education in "trust accounts and contracts or approved forms and three (3) hours in ethics" by August 16, 2013. On April 22, 2014, Respondent's real estate broker license was suspended for failure to complete the education as ordered.
