On August 23, 2012, the Wisconsin Chiropractic Examining Board ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") limiting Respondent's license to practice as a chiropractor. Respondent was required to complete 8 hours of education and notify Medicare and Medicaid of his period of working with an expired credential pursuant to the Order.
