On September 9, 2012, the Wisconsin Pharmacy Examining Board ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") suspending Respondent's pharmacist license for an indefinite period. Respondent has been granted a stay of suspension and his license is currently limited with certain terms and conditions.

On March 26, 2014, the Board considered Respondent's requests for a reduction in the frequency of drug and alcohol screens and the ability to work as a pharmacist-in-charge. Based upon the information of record, the Board finds and makes the following:

ORDER

- 1. Respondent's request for a reduction in drug and alcohol screens is hereby GRANTED. Respondent's frequency is reduced to 36 urine screens per year and one annual hair test.
- 2. Respondent's request for the ability to work as a pharmacist-in-charge is hereby GRANTED. Respondent may work in this capacity for up to 16 hours in any given seven (7) day period.
- 3. All other terms and conditions of the Order not otherwise modified remain in full force and effect.
 - 4. This order is effective the date of its signing.
