On September 9, 2012, the Wisconsin Pharmacy Examining Board ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") suspending Respondent's pharmacist license for an indefinite period. Respondent has been granted a stay of suspension and his license is currently limited with certain terms and conditions.

On March 26, 2014, the Board considered Respondent's requests for a reduction in the frequency of drug and alcohol screens and the ability to work as a pharmacist-in-charge. Based upon the information of record, the Board finds and makes the following:

ORDER

1. Respondent's request for a reduction in drug and alcohol screens is hereby GRANTED. Respondent's frequency is reduced to 36 urine screens per year and one annual hair test.
2. Respondent's request for the ability to work as a pharmacist-in-charge is hereby GRANTED. Respondent may work in this capacity for up to 16 hours in any given seven (7) day period.
3. All other terms and conditions of the Order not otherwise modified remain in full force and effect.
4. This order is effective the date of its signing.
