On September 19, 2012, the Medical Examining Board ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") suspending Respondent's license to practice medicine and surgery in the state of Wisconsin (#25006-20) for an indefinite period. Prior to applying for reinstatement, Respondent must appear before the Board and prove that he is able to safely and competently practice in Wisconsin.

On September 18, 2014, the Board considered Respondent's request for termination of the suspension. Respondent appeared before the Board on behalf of his request. Based upon the information of record, the Board finds and makes the following:

ORDER

1. Respondent's request for termination of the suspension is hereby DENIED. The Board will not consider any request to terminate or rescind the suspension prior to March 31, 2015. Respondent has not presented to the Board evidence sufficient to establish his ability to safely and competently resume the practice of medicine and surgery.
