On December 11, 2013, the Wisconsin Medical Examining Board ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") limiting Respondent's license to practice medicine and surgery. Respondent was limited in that he had to comply with the terms of the September 8, 2012, Order of the Minnesota Board of Medical Practice.

Respondent has submitted proof that he satisfied the terms of the Minnesota order and his license in Minnesota has been returned to unrestricted status.

ORDER

1. Respondent's medicine and surgery license (#22298-20) is returned to full, unrestricted status.
2. All limitations and encumbrances upon Respondent's credential are removed.
