On February 13, 2013, the Wisconsin Real Estate Appraisers Board issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") requiring Respondent to complete 75 hours of education including: USPAP (15 hours); Residential Sales Comparison & Income Approaches (30 hours); Residential Site Valuation & Cost Approach (15 hours); and/or Residential Market Analysis & Highest and Best Use (15 hours); and/or Residential Report Writing & Case Studies within one (1) year. The information of record demonstrates that Respondent has failed to comply with the education requirements and as a result the following is entered:
