On August 14, 2013, the Wisconsin Medical Examining Board ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") suspending Respondent's license to practice medicine and surgery for an indefinite period. Respondent has been granted a stay of suspension and his license is currently limited with certain terms and conditions.

Information has been received that demonstrates Respondent is in substantial and repeated violation of sections C and D of the Order dated August 14, 2013 and, as a result, the following is entered:

1. The stay of suspension is removed and Respondent's license to practice medicine and surgery (#24871-20) is hereby SUSPENDED until further notice.
