On September 18, 2013, the Wisconsin Medical Examining Board ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") suspending Respondent's license to practice medicine and surgery for an indefinite period. Respondent has been granted a stay of suspension and her license is currently limited with certain terms and conditions.

On July 16, 2014, the Board considered Respondent's request for permission to return to the practice of anesthesiology, elimination of the AA/NA attendance requirement and a reduction in the frequency of drug and alcohol treatment sessions. Based upon the information of record, the Board finds and makes the following:

ORDER

1. Respondent's request for the removal of Anesthesiology practice restrictions is GRANTED.
2. Respondent's request for termination of the AA/NA requirement is hereby GRANTED.
3. Respondent's request for a reduction in the frequency of drug and alcohol treatment sessions is GRANTED and shall occur as recommended by Treater pursuant to provision C.4. of the Order.
4. All other terms and conditions of the Order not otherwise modified remain in full force and effect.
5. This order is effective the date of its signing.
