On May 7, 2013, the Wisconsin Department of Safety and Professional Services ("Department") issued an Order Granting Limited License ("Order") suspending Applicant's substance abuse counselor credential for an indefinite period. Applicant was granted an immediate stay of suspension allowing her to practice as a substance abuse counselor with certain terms and conditions. Applicant also holds a professional nursing license with similar limitations.

On February 13, 2014, the Board of Nursing granted Applicant a reduction in the frequency of screens to twenty-eight (28) per year. Based upon the information of record, which demonstrates that Applicant is eligible for a reduction at this time, the following is entered:

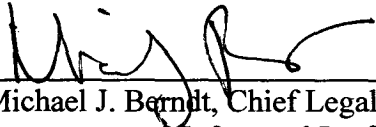
ORDER

1. Applicant's request for a reduction in drug and alcohol screens is hereby GRANTED. Applicant's frequency is reduced to twenty-eight per year.

2. All other terms and conditions of the Order not otherwise modified remain in full force and effect.
