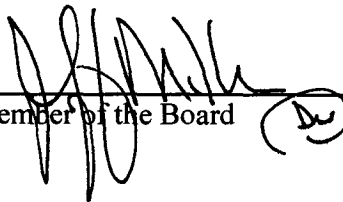
On May 9, 2013, the Wisconsin Board of Nursing ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") suspending Respondent's professional nursing license for an indefinite period. Respondent has been granted a stay of suspension and her license is currently limited with certain terms and conditions.

On July 10, 2014, the Board considered Respondent's request for a reduction in the frequency of drug and alcohol screens. Based upon the information of record, the Board finds and makes the following:

ORDER

1. Respondent's request for a reduction in the frequency of drug and alcohol screens is hereby DENIED based on insufficient time under the Order to determine compliance.
