On June 27, 2013, the Wisconsin Real Estate Examining Board issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") requiring Respondent to complete twelve (12) hours of education on the topic of trust accounts and financial management within 90 days. Respondent was also required to submit monthly reports including a trial balance, bank statements, a reconciliation and a check register for the period. The information of record demonstrates that Respondent has failed to comply with the Board-ordered education and failed to submit any monthly reports and, as a result, the following is entered:
