On June 27, 2013, the Wisconsin Real Estate Examining Board issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") requiring Respondent to complete 12 hours of education on the topic of trust accounts and financial management within 90 days. Respondent was also required to submit monthly reports including a trail balance, bank statements, a reconciliation and a check register for the period of 6 months. On January 2, 2014, Respondent's real estate broker's license was suspended for failure to comply with the ordered requirements.

Based upon the information of record, which includes proof that Respondent has now completed the education and filed the papers listed in the above paragraph, the following is entered:

ORDER

1. The suspension of Respondent's real estate broker's license #52811-90 is terminated.
2. All other terms and conditions of the Order not otherwise modified remain in full force and effect.
