On July 11, 2013, the Wisconsin Board of Nursing ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") suspending Respondent's professional nursing license for an indefinite period. Respondent has been granted a stay of suspension and his license is currently limited with certain terms and conditions.

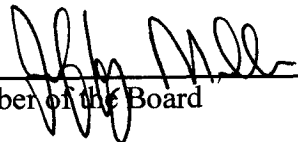
On November 13, 2014, the Board considered Respondent's request for the return full, unrestricted license or, in the event full licensure is not granted, termination of direct supervision with the ability to work as a pool nurse or in an agency setting and a reduction in drug and alcohol screens. Based upon the information of record, the Board finds and makes the following:

ORDER

1. Respondent's request for full, unrestricted licensure is hereby DENIED due to insufficient time under the Order.
2. Respondent's request for termination of direct supervision with the ability to work as a pool nurse or in an agency setting is hereby DENIED due to insufficient time under the Order.
3. Respondent's request for a reduction in drug and alcohol screens is hereby GRANTED. Respondent's frequency is reduced to 36 per year.
4. All other terms and conditions of the Order not otherwise modified remain in full force and effect.
5. This order is effective the date of its signing.
