On July 17, 2013, the Wisconsin Pharmacy Examining Board ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") suspending Respondent's pharmacy license for an indefinite period. Respondent has been granted a stay of suspension and his license is currently limited with certain terms and conditions.

On November 12, 2014, the Board considered Respondent's request for reduction of NA/AA meetings, termination of alcohol restriction, and reduction of drug and alcohol screens. Based upon the information of record, the Board finds and makes the following:

#### **ORDER**

- 1. Respondent's request for reduction of NA/AA meetings is hereby GRANTED. Respondent's NA/AA requirement is lowered from two (2) times per week to one (1) time per week.
- 2. Respondent's request for reduction of drug and alcohol screens in hereby GRANTED. The frequency of Respondent's drug and alcohol screens is lowered from 49 per year to 36 per year.
  - 3. Respondent's request for removal of his alcohol restriction is hereby DENIED.
- 4. All other terms and conditions of the Order not otherwise modified remain in full force and effect.
  - 5. This order is effective the date of its signing.
