On July 17, 2013, the Wisconsin Pharmacy Examining Board ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") suspending Respondent's pharmacy license for an indefinite period. Respondent has been granted a stay of suspension and his license is currently limited with certain terms and conditions.

On November 12, 2014, the Board considered Respondent's request for reduction of NA/AA meetings, termination of alcohol restriction, and reduction of drug and alcohol screens. Based upon the information of record, the Board finds and makes the following:

ORDER

1. Respondent's request for reduction of NA/AA meetings is hereby GRANTED. Respondent's NA/AA requirement is lowered from two (2) times per week to one (1) time per week.
2. Respondent's request for reduction of drug and alcohol screens is hereby GRANTED. The frequency of Respondent's drug and alcohol screens is lowered from 49 per year to 36 per year.
3. Respondent's request for removal of his alcohol restriction is hereby DENIED.
4. All other terms and conditions of the Order not otherwise modified remain in full force and effect.
5. This order is effective the date of its signing.
