On August 15, 2013, the Wisconsin Chiropractic Examining Board ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") suspending Respondent's license to practice chiropractic for 30 days and limiting the license with certain terms and conditions for an indefinite period.

On March 6, 2014, the Board considered Respondent's request for the return of full, unrestricted licensure. Based upon the information of record, the Board finds and makes the following:
