
On December 19, 2013, the Wisconsin Board of Nursing ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") limiting Respondent's professional nursing license. Respondent was required to complete two (2) hours of education on the topic of medication administration and two (2) hours of education on the topic of verifying/entering physician orders.

Respondent has submitted proof that she successfully completed the Board-ordered education and, as a result, the following is entered:

1. Respondent's professional nursing license (#115455-30) is returned to full, unrestricted status.
2. All limitations and encumbrances upon Respondent's credential are removed.
