On January 15, 2014, the Wisconsin Medical Examining ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") limiting Respondent's license to practice medicine and surgery. Respondent was required to complete 10 hours of education on the topic of diagnosis and treatment of dermatologic cancer, including diagnosis of cancer in the head and neck pursuant to the Order.
