On March 6, 2014, the Wisconsin Chiropractic Examining ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") limiting Respondent's license to practice chiropractic. Respondent was required to notify Medicare and Medicaid that he had practiced with an expired license.

Respondent has submitted proof that he successfully complied with the Board-ordered requirement that he notifies Medicare and Medicaid and, as a result, the following is entered:

ORDER

1. Respondent's chiropractic license (#1340-12) is returned to full, unrestricted status.
