
On March 13, 2014, the Wisconsin Board of Nursing ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") limiting Respondent's professional nursing license. Respondent was required to complete three (3) hours of education on the topic of ethics and three (3) hours on the topic of medication administration, wasting medications in particular, pursuant to the Order.
