
On March 13, 2014, the Wisconsin Board of Nursing ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") limiting Respondent's practical nursing license. Respondent was required to complete three (3) hours of education on the topic of ethics and professionalism in nursing pursuant to the Order.
