On April 16, 2014, the Wisconsin Medical Examining Board ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") limiting Respondent's medicine and surgery license. Respondent was required to complete continuing education on the topic of prescribing psychotropic medications, prescribing controlled substances, medical documentation and 5 hours in informed consent including its documentation pursuant to the terms of the Order.
