The parties in this matter agree to the terms and conditions of the attached Stipulation as the final disposition of this matter, subject to the approval of the Psychology Examining Board (Board). The Board has reviewed this Stipulation and considers it acceptable.

Accordingly, the Board in this matter adopts the attached Stipulation and makes the following Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Order.

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. Respondent Raymond G. Lueck, Psy.D., (dob May 15, 1952) is licensed in the State of Wisconsin as a psychologist, having license number 1434-57, first granted on March 15, 1989, and current through September 30, 2015. Raymond G. Lueck's most recent address on file with the Wisconsin Department of Safety and Professional Services (Department) is 2500 N. Mayfair Road, Suite 560, Wauwatosa, Wisconsin 53226.
- 2. On July 17, 2013, Respondent was arrested at Taycheeda Correctional Institution while visiting an inmate. On January 29, 2014, in Fond du Lac County Circuit Court Case

Number 2013CF354, Respondent pled guilty to Wis. Stat. § 961.41(1m)(d) based on his July 17, 2013, arrest.

- 3. Respondent agrees that there is sufficient evidence from which the Psychology Examining Board could reasonably conclude that he engaged in unprofessional conduct.
- 4. Respondent tenders the surrender of his license to practice psychology in Wisconsin.
- 5. In resolution of this matter, Respondent consents to the entry of the following Conclusions of Law and Order.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- 1. The Wisconsin Psychology Examining Board has jurisdiction to act in this matter pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 455.09, and is authorized to enter into the attached Stipulation pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 227.44(5).
- 2. Under the circumstances of this case, Wis. Stat. § 961.41(1m)(d) is a law the circumstances of which substantially relate to the practice of psychology
- 3. By the conduct described in the Findings of Fact, Raymond G. Lueck, Psy. D., violated Wis. Admin. Code § Psy 5.01(5) by violating a law, Wis. Stat. § 961.41(1m)(d) the circumstances of which substantially relate to the practice of psychology.
- 4. As a result of the above violations, Raymond G. Lueck, Psy. D., is subject to discipline pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 455.09(1)(g).

ORDER

- 1. The attached Stipulation is accepted.
- 2. Respondent Raymond G. Lueck, Psy.D.'s SURRENDER of his license and all right to renew his license (no. 1434-57) is ACCEPTED.
- 3. Within 90 days from the date of this Order, Raymond G. Lueck, Psy.D., shall pay COSTS of this matter in the amount of \$225.00.
- 4. Payment of costs shall be made payable to the Wisconsin Department of Safety and Professional Services and sent by Respondent to the Department Monitor at the address below:

Respondent Raymond G. Lueck, Psy.D., and the Division of Legal Services and Compliance, Department of Safety and Professional Services stipulate as follows:

- 1. This Stipulation is entered into as a result of a pending investigation by the Division of Legal Services and Compliance. Respondent consents to the resolution of this investigation by Stipulation.
- 2. Respondent understands that by signing this Stipulation, Respondent voluntarily and knowingly waives the following rights:
 - the right to a hearing on the allegations against Respondent, at which time the State has the burden of proving those allegations by a preponderance of the evidence;
 - the right to confront and cross-examine the witnesses against Respondent;
 - the right to call witnesses on Respondent's behalf and to compel their attendance by subpoena;
 - the right to testify on Respondent's own behalf;
 - the right to file objections to any proposed decision and to present briefs or oral arguments to the officials who are to render the final decision;
 - the right to petition for rehearing; and
 - all other applicable rights afforded to Respondent under the United States Constitution, the Wisconsin Constitution, the Wisconsin Statutes, the Wisconsin Administrative Code, and other provisions of state or federal law.
- 3. Respondent is aware of Respondent's right to seek legal representation and has been provided an opportunity to obtain legal counsel before signing this Stipulation. Respondent is represented by Tyler Wilkinson.
- 4. Respondent agrees to the adoption of the attached Final Decision and Order by the Wisconsin Psychology Examining Board (Board). The parties to the Stipulation consent to the entry of the attached Final Decision and Order without further notice, pleading, appearance or consent of the parties. Respondent waives all rights to any appeal of the Board's order, if adopted in the form as attached.

- 5. If the terms of this Stipulation are not acceptable to the Board, the parties shall not be bound by the contents of this Stipulation, and the matter shall then be returned to the Division of Legal Services and Compliance for further proceedings. In the event that the Stipulation is not accepted by the Board, the parties agree not to contend that the Board has been prejudiced or biased in any manner by the consideration of this attempted resolution.
- 6. The parties to this Stipulation agree that the attorney or other agent for the Division of Legal Services and Compliance and any member of the Board ever assigned as an advisor in this investigation may appear before the Board in open or closed session, without the presence of Respondent or Respondent's attorney, for purposes of speaking in support of this agreement and answering questions that any member of the Board may have in connection with deliberations on the Stipulation. Additionally, any such advisor may vote on whether the Board should accept this Stipulation and issue the attached Final Decision and Order.
- 7. Respondent is informed that should the Board adopt this Stipulation, the Board's Final Decision and Order is a public record and will be published in accordance with standard Department procedure.
- 8. The Division of Legal Services and Compliance joins Respondent in recommending the Board adopt this Stipulation and issue the attached Final Decision and Order.
