On June 12, 2014, the Wisconsin Board of Nursing issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") limiting Respondent's professional nursing license with certain terms and conditions. Pursuant to the Order, Respondent's license may be suspended without hearing for substantial or repeated violation of any provision. Respondent's license may also be suspended for failure to complete six hours of education in medication errors and five hours in documentation within 90 days.


Information has been received that demonstrates Respondent is in violation of the Order by failing to enroll and participate in an approved drug monitoring program and failing to complete the education requirements. Therefore, the following is entered:

ORDER

1. Respondent's professional nursing license (#150531-30) is hereby SUSPENDED until further notice.
2. This order is effective five (5) days from the date of its signing.
