PROCEDURAL HISTORY

The parties have agreed to the terms and conditions of the attached Stipulation and Interim Order in this matter, subject to the approval of the Board of Nursing (Board). The Board has reviewed this Stipulation and considers it acceptable.

Accordingly, the Board adopts the attached Stipulation and makes the following Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Order:

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. Respondent Stefanie Jones, R.N., (dob April 28, 1983) is licensed in the State of Wisconsin as a professional nurse, having license number 185057-30, first issued on April 11, 2012 and current through February 29, 2016. Respondent's most recent address on file with the Wisconsin Department of Safety and Professional Services is 102 B Maria Lane, Cottage Grove, Wisconsin 53527-8927.
- 2. On May 5, 2014, the Division of Legal Services and Compliance opened an investigation of Respondent on behalf of the Board. That investigation is based on allegations

that Respondent diverted controlled substances (hydromorphone and morphine) from a clinic, located in Madison, Wisconsin.

- 3. The Board has not made a determination as to the validity of the above allegations.
- 4. Respondent has voluntarily agreed not to engage in the practice of professional nursing pending the final resolution of these disciplinary matters.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. The Wisconsin Board of Nursing has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 441.07.

ORDER

- 1. The license to practice professional nursing in the State of Wisconsin of Respondent Stefanie Jones, R.N., is hereby SUSPENDED, during the pendency of these disciplinary matters.
- 2. The suspension shall continue until the Board issues a Final Decision and Order in these disciplinary matters.
 - 3. This Order is effective on the date of its signing.

Respondent Stefanie Jones, R.N., and the Division of Legal Services and Compliance, Department of Safety and Professional Services stipulate as follows:

- This Stipulation is entered into as a result of a pending investigation by the Division of Legal Services and Compliance. Respondent consents to the temporary resolution.
- Respondent understands that by signing this Stipulation, Respondent voluntarily 2. and knowingly waives the following rights as they pertain to the attached interim order:
 - the right to a hearing on the allegations against Respondent, at which time the State has the burden of proving those allegations by a preponderance of the evidence;
 - the right to confront and cross-examine the witnesses against Respondent;
 - the right to call witnesses on Respondent's behalf and to compel their attendance by subpoena;
 - the right to testify on Respondent's own behalf;
 - the right to file objections to any proposed decision and to present briefs or oral arguments to the officials who are to render the final decision;
 - the right to petition for rehearing; and
 - all other applicable rights afforded to Respondent under the United States Constitution, the Wisconsin Constitution, the Wisconsin Statutes, the Wisconsin Administrative Code, and other provisions of state or federal law.
- Respondent is aware of Respondent's right to seek legal representation and has been provided an opportunity to obtain legal counsel before signing this Stipulation. Respondent is represented by Attorney Nicholas E. Fairweather.
- Respondent neither admits nor denies the allegations in this matter, but agrees to 4. the adoption of the attached Interim Order by the Board of Nursing. The parties to the Stipulation consent to the entry of the attached Interim Order without further notice, pleading, appearance or consent of the parties. Respondent waives all rights to any appeal of the Board's order, if adopted in the form as attached.
- If the terms of this Stipulation are not acceptable to the Board, the parties shall not be bound by the contents of this Stipulation, and the matter shall be returned to the Division of Legal Services and Compliance for further proceedings. In the event that this Stipulation is not

accepted by the Board, the parties agree not to contend that the Board has been prejudiced or biased in any manner by the consideration of this attempted resolution.

- 6. The parties to this Stipulation agree that the attorney or other agent for the Division of Legal Services and Compliance and any member of the Board ever assigned as a case advisor in this investigation may appear before the Board in open or closed session, without the presence of Respondent or Respondent's attorney, if any, for purposes of speaking in support of this agreement and answering questions that any member of the Board may have in connection with the Board's deliberations on the Stipulation. Additionally, any such case advisor may vote on whether the Board should accept this Stipulation and issue the attached interim Order.
- 7. Respondent is informed that should the Board adopt this Stipulation, the Board's Interim Order is a public record and will be published in accordance with standard Department procedure.
- 8. The Division of Legal Services and Compliance joins Respondent in recommending that the Board adopt this Stipulation and issue the attached Interim Order.
