On September 3, 2014, the Wisconsin Dentistry Examining Board ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") suspending Respondent's dental license (#2962-15) for an indefinite period. Respondent may petition the Board for stay of the suspension after providing proof, which is determined by the Board or its designee to be sufficient, that Respondent is in compliance with the provisions of Sections C and D of this Order.

On September 3, 2014, the Board's designee considered Respondent's request for stay of the suspension. Based upon the information of record, the Board finds and makes the following:

ORDER

1. Respondent's request for stay of the suspension is hereby DENIED because Respondent has not established a pattern of compliance with the Order.
2. Respondent shall not re-petition the Board for a stay until he is able to show at least six (6) consecutive negative drug and alcohol screens obtained pursuant to the Order.
3. This order is effective the date of its signing.
