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

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On December 11, 2014, the Wisconsin Board of Nursing (Board), met to consider the Proposed Decision and Order submitted by ALJ Jennifer Nashold concerning the disciplinary proceedings against Yvette Harris, R.N. (DHA Case No. SPS-14-0049, DLSC Case No. 13 NUR 133). Accompanying the Proposed Decision and Order were objections submitted by Attorney Diane Welsh, on behalf of the Respondent, and responses to those objections submitted by Attorney Kim Kluck.
