On August 8, 2003, the Wisconsin Board of Nursing ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") suspending Respondent's professional nursing license for an indefinite period. Respondent has been granted a stay of suspension and her license is currently limited with certain terms and conditions.

On October 8, 2015, the Board considered Respondent's request for access to controlled substances in the workplace. Based upon the information of record, the Board finds and makes the following:

ORDER

1. Respondent's request for access to controlled substances is hereby DENIED due to failure to demonstrate continuous and successful compliance. Respondent needs to fully comply with the complete terms and conditions of the Order for at least six (6) months, which includes working as a nurse, before the Board will consider modifications.
2. All other terms and conditions of the Order not otherwise modified remain in full force and effect.
3. This order is effective the date of its signing.
