On January 27, 2005, the Wisconsin Board of Nursing ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") suspending Respondent's license for an indefinite period. On May 17, 2011 the Board denied Respondent's request to extend the stay of the suspension, reverting the license back to suspended status. On December 16, 2011 the Board Ordered that Respondent may not petition for a stay of the suspension until she provides a fitness to practice evaluation. Respondent has submitted a completed fitness to practice evaluation dated July 13, 2015.

On November 12, 2015, the Board considered Respondent's request for reinstatement of full licensure. Based upon the information of record, the Board finds and makes the following:

#### **ORDER**

- 1. The Board GRANTS a stay of suspension. Respondent's license is limited to the terms of the Order dated January 27, 2005.
- 2. Respondent's request for reinstatement of full licensure is hereby DENIED. Respondent must work under the original terms of the Board Order and demonstrate continuous, successful compliance for a period of at least five years.
- 3. All other terms and conditions of the Order not otherwise modified remain in full force and effect.
  - 4. This order is effective the date of its signing.
