On February 8, 2006, the Wisconsin Pharmacy Examining Board ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") limiting Respondent's pharmacist license. Respondent was required to complete and pass the Multi-state Pharmacy Jurisprudence Exam (MPJE), pay a forfeiture, complete five (5) hours of education in general continuing education, and complete fifteen (15) hours of education in patient consultation and pharmacy work flow improvement pursuant to the terms of the Order.

Respondent has submitted proof that he successfully completed all requirements and as a result the following is entered:

1. Respondent's pharmacist license (#8940-40) is returned to full, unrestricted status.
