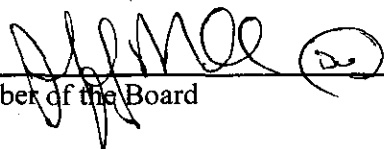
On March 1, 2007, the Wisconsin Board of Nursing ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") suspending Respondent's professional nursing license for an indefinite period. Respondent has been granted a stay of suspension and his license is currently limited with certain terms and conditions.

On October 8, 2015, the Board considered Respondent's request for termination of the direct supervision requirement. Based upon the information of record, the Board finds and makes the following:

ORDER

1. Respondent's request for termination of the direct supervision requirement is hereby DENIED due to insufficient time of compliance under the terms of the Order.
2. All other terms and conditions of the Order not otherwise modified remain in full force and effect.
3. This order is effective the date of its signing.
