On July 26, 2007, the Wisconsin Board of Nursing ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") suspending Respondent's license for an indefinite period. Respondent has been granted a stay of suspension and her license is currently limited with certain terms and conditions.

On November 12, 2015, the Board considered Respondent's request for the return of full licensure. Based upon the information of record, the Board finds and makes the following:

ORDER

1. Respondent's request for the return of her license (303621-31) to full, unrestricted status is hereby DENIED due to Respondent's failure to demonstrate continuous and successful compliance under the terms of the order dated 8/9/2010. The respondent needs to submit quarterly work reports for a period of one year.
