On May 14, 2010, the Wisconsin Board of Nursing ("Board") issued an Order Granting Reinstatement of Licensure with Limitations ("Order"), which reinstated Respondent's license after a previous revocation. Respondent's license was indefinitely suspended upon reinstatement and the suspension was stayed contingent upon Respondent's compliance with the terms and conditions of the Order.

On October 8, 2015, the Board considered Respondent's request for full, unrestricted licensure or, in the alternative, termination of direct supervision and a reduction in drug and alcohol screens. Based upon the information of record, the Board finds and makes the following:

ORDER

1. Respondent's request for full, unrestricted licensure or, alternatively, termination of direct supervision and a reduction in drug and alcohol screens is hereby DENIED for failure to demonstrate continuous and successful compliance. Respondent needs to fully comply with the complete terms and conditions of the Order before the Board will consider modifications.
2. All other terms and conditions of the Order not otherwise modified remain in full force and effect.
3. This order is effective the date of its signing.
