On January 22, 2009, the Wisconsin Board of Nursing ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order LS09012212NUR") suspending Respondent's professional nursing license for an indefinite period. Respondent has been granted a stay of suspension allowing her to practice with a limited license under certain terms and conditions.

On June 7, 2012, the Board issued a second Final Decision and Order ("Order 0001818") further limiting Respondent's license with additional requirements, including the completion of four (4) hours of education in documentation and four (4) hours in safe medication administration. Respondent has submitted proof of completion of these hours pursuant to Order 0001818.

On January 8, 2015, the Board considered Respondent's request for the return of full, unrestricted licensure. Based upon the information of record, the Board finds and makes the following:

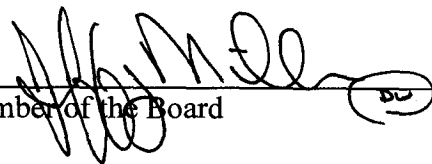
ORDER
