On February 26, 2009, the Wisconsin Board of Nursing ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") suspending Respondent's professional nursing license for an indefinite period. Respondent has been granted a stay of suspension and her license is currently limited with certain terms and conditions.

On April 9, 2015, the Board considered Respondent's request for the return of full licensure. Based upon the information of record, the Board finds and makes the following:

ORDER

1. Respondent's request for the return of her professional nursing license (#143383-30) to full, unrestricted status is hereby DENIED for failure to demonstrate continuous and successful compliance. The Board will not consider further requests until Respondent has demonstrated full compliance with all terms of the Order, including daily check-ins with the drug and alcohol monitoring program (FirstLab), for twelve (12) months.
