On September 23, 2009, the Wisconsin Pharmacy Examining Board ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") suspending Respondent's pharmacist license for an indefinite period. Respondent has been granted a stay of suspension and her license is currently limited with certain terms and conditions.



On June 3, 2015, the Board considered Respondent's request for the return of full licensure. Based upon the information of record, the Board finds and makes the following:

ORDER

1. Respondent's request for the return of her pharmacist license (#14955-40) to full, unrestricted status is DENIED. The Board requires further compliance under the current terms of the Order and requires a request for and successful completion of a period of PIC hours before full licensure will be considered.
