On September 23, 2009, the Wisconsin Pharmacy Examining Board ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") suspending Respondent's pharmacist license for an indefinite period. Respondent has been granted a stay of suspension and her license is currently limited with certain terms and conditions.

On July 22, 2015, the Board considered Respondent's request for a reduction of drug and alcohol screens and PIC hours to be granted. Based upon the information of record, the Board finds and makes the following:


ORDER
