On October 20, 2011, the Wisconsin Board of Nursing ("Board") issued an Order Granting Reinstatement of License with Limitations ("Order"), which reinstated Respondent's professional nursing license with an indefinite suspension following a previous revocation. Respondent has been granted a stay of suspension and her license is currently limited with certain terms and conditions.

On June 11, 2015, the Board considered Respondent's request for the return of full licensure. Respondent appeared before the Board on behalf of her request. Based upon the information of record, the Board finds and makes the following:

ORDER

1. Respondent's request for the return of her professional nursing license (#138267-30) to full, unrestricted status is hereby DENIED. Respondent has not demonstrated continuous, successful compliance with the terms of the Order for at least two years.
