On January 28, 2010, the Wisconsin Board of Nursing ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") suspending Respondent's professional nursing license for an indefinite period. Respondent has been granted a stay of suspension and her license is currently limited with certain terms and conditions. Furthermore, Respondent failed to renew her license by the February 28, 2014 deadline and her license is currently expired.

Information has been received that demonstrates Respondent is in violation of the terms of the Order and, as a result, the following is entered:

ORDER

1. The stay of suspension is removed and Respondent's right to renew her professional nursing license (#81404-30) is hereby SUSPENDED until further notice.
2. Respondent may petition the Board or its designee for reinstatement of the stay upon demonstrating continuous compliance with the terms and conditions of the Order for at least the most recent three (3) months.
3. The temporary reductions in drug and alcohol screens, granted on March 4, 2013 and April 6, 2015, are hereby removed and Respondent's frequency is returned to not less than 48 times per year.
4. This order is effective immediately.
