On March 3, 2010, the Wisconsin Dentistry Examining Board ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") suspending Respondent's dentistry license for an indefinite period. Respondent has been granted a stay of suspension and his license is currently limited with certain terms and conditions.

On May 6, 2015, the Board considered Respondent's request for the return of full licensure. Based upon the information of record, the Board finds and makes the following:

ORDER

1. Respondent's request for the return of his dentistry license (#3934-15) to full, unrestricted status is hereby DENIED due to lack of continuous compliance with the Order. Furthermore, the Board will not consider requests for modifications until the Respondent has demonstrated compliance with all terms of the Order for at least one (1) full year.
