On May 6, 2010, the Wisconsin Board of Nursing ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") reprimanding Respondent and requiring him to submit a physiological specimen for analysis upon request. On or around July 6, 2011, Respondent failed to comply with the Department's request for a drug screen. As a result, Respondent's professional nursing license was suspended on September 15, 2011.

Respondent has submitted a request for termination of the suspension and, upon the Department Monitor's request, provided a hair sample for analysis which was negative for any controlled substances. The information of record demonstrates that Respondent has completed all requirements of the Order and therefore the following is entered:

ORDER

1. Respondent's request for termination of the suspension of his professional nursing license (#152257-30) is hereby GRANTED.
2. All limitations and encumbrances upon Respondent's credential are hereby removed.
