On May 6, 2010, the Wisconsin Board of Nursing ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") suspending Respondent's practical nursing license for 45 days and subsequently limiting the license with several terms and conditions.

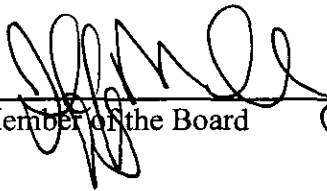
On June 11, 2015, the Board considered Respondent's request for removal of the limitations and the return of her license to full, unrestricted status. Based upon the information of record, the Board finds and makes the following:

ORDER

1. Respondent's request for the return of her practical nursing license to full, unrestricted status is hereby DENIED due to failure to demonstrate continuous successful compliance. Respondent must fully comply with the terms and conditions of the Order, including the submission of quarterly work reports, for at least one year before the Board will consider further petitions for modification.
