On November 3, 2010, the Wisconsin Dentistry Examining Board ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") suspending Respondent's dental license for an indefinite period. Respondent has been granted a stay of suspension and his license is currently limited with certain terms and conditions.

On November 4, 2015, the Board considered Respondent's request for removal of all Impairment requirements (AA/NA meetings, drug screens, supervisor reports and respondent reports) and termination of limitation that Respondent not perform third molar extractions. Based upon the information of record, the Board finds and makes the following:

ORDER

1. Respondent's request for termination of Impairment requirements (AA/NA meetings, drug screens, supervisor reports, and respondent reports) is hereby GRANTED.
2. Respondent's request for termination of the limitation that Respondent not perform third molar extractions is hereby DENIED because Respondent has not demonstrated minimum standards of competence to perform such procedures.
3. Dr. Slavik will be allowed to perform third molar extractions under the direct supervision of Dr. Welsh. Dr. Welsh will provide reports. After three (3) reports from three (3) different patients, the Board liaison may consider lifting the limitation on third molar extractions.
4. All other terms and conditions of the Order not otherwise modified remain in full force and effect.
5. This order is effective the date of its signing.
