On January 27, 2011, the Wisconsin Board of Nursing ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") suspending Respondent's professional nursing license for an indefinite period. Respondent has been granted a stay of suspension and her license is currently limited with certain terms and conditions.

On February 12, 2015, the Board considered Respondent's request for permission to work as a nurse with access to controlled substances, particularly ADHD medications. Based upon the information of record, the Board finds and makes the following:

ORDER

1. Respondent's request for access to controlled substances is hereby DENIED due to failure to comply with the current terms of the Order. Respondent must practice under the current terms and conditions of the Order, and demonstrate full compliance with such terms, before the Board will consider any requests for modification.
