On May 4, 2011, the Wisconsin Dentistry Board ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") suspending Respondent's dentistry license for an indefinite period. Respondent has been granted a stay of suspension and his license is currently limited with certain terms and conditions.

On May 6, 2015, the Board considered Respondent's request for a reduction in the frequency of drug and alcohol screens and termination of the drug and alcohol treatment requirement. Based upon the information of record, the Board finds and makes the following:

ORDER

1. Respondent's request for a reduction in drug and alcohol screens is hereby GRANTED. Respondent's frequency is reduced to 14 urine screens per year and one (1) annual hair test.
2. Respondent's request for termination of the drug and alcohol treatment requirement is hereby GRANTED.
3. All other terms and conditions of the Order not otherwise modified remain in full force and effect.
4. This order is effective the date of its signing.
