On May 5, 2011, the Wisconsin Board of Nursing ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order suspending Respondent's professional nursing license (#119274-30) for an indefinite period. Respondent was required to complete certain conditions prior to petitioning the Board for termination of the suspension.

On October 8, 2015, the Board considered Respondent's request for termination of the suspension. Based upon the information of record, the Board finds and makes the following:

ORDER



1. Respondent's request to terminate the suspension imposed pursuant to the Order is hereby GRANTED.
2. Respondent's license is hereby LIMITED as follows:
  - a. For a period of at least one (1) year, Respondent shall arrange for his nursing supervisor(s) to submit quarterly work reports as directed by the Department Monitor. These reports shall assess Respondent's work performance and include the number of hours of active nursing practice worked during that quarter.
  - b. Respondent may petition the Board for termination of the limitation after one (1) year of working at least half-time as a nurse. The Board may grant or deny the petition, in its discretion, or may modify this order as it sees fit.
