On July 21, 2011, the Wisconsin Board of Nursing ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") limiting Respondent's license with certain terms and conditions. Respondent may petition the Board for removal of the limitations upon the completion of the conditions in the Order.

On November 12, 2015, the Board considered Respondent's request for removal of the limitations and the return of her license to full, unrestricted status. Based upon the information of record, the Board finds and makes the following:

ORDER

1. Respondent's request for the return of her license to full, *unrestricted* status is hereby DENIED due to insufficient time of compliance under the terms of the Order.
2. The Board requests that the respondent submit quarterly work reports for an additional period of six (6) months that are satisfactory to the Board.
