On January 26, 2012, the Wisconsin Board of Nursing ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") suspending Respondent's professional nursing license for an indefinite period. Respondent has been granted a stay of suspension and her license is currently limited with certain terms and conditions.

On July 9, 2015, the Board considered Respondent's request for a reduction in AA/NA meetings, a reduction in drug and alcohol screens, and for permission to work as a nurse with access to controlled substances. Based upon the information of record, the Board finds and makes the following:

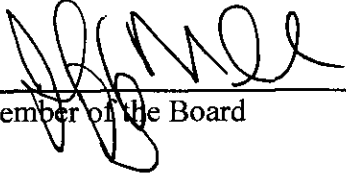
ORDER
