On January 26, 2012, the Wisconsin Board of Nursing ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") suspending Respondent's practical nursing license for an indefinite period. Respondent has been granted a stay of suspension and her license is currently limited with certain terms and conditions.

On October 13, 2015, the Board's designee considered Respondent's request to terminate the requirement for drug and alcohol treatment. Based upon the information of record, including a written recommendation from Respondent's Treater, the Board's designee finds and makes the following:

1. Respondent's request for termination of the drug and alcohol treatment requirement is hereby GRANTED.
2. All other terms and conditions of the Order not otherwise modified remain in full force and effect.
